Driving restrictions

Are there any driving restrictions on international HGV traffic at weekends or on public holidays? **No**

There is no general restriction on international HGV traffic at weekends or on public holidays in Belgium. However, transport of abnormal loads is subject to specific bans.

Additional information

Starting from 1 October 2020, the Beveren Tunnel is to be assigned to category D. As a result, a lot of ADR traffic will no longer be permitted to use the tunnel. Calamity routes T and U are the diversion routes for these ADR transport runs.

Except for abnormal load vehicles not exceeding a mass of 60t, a width exceeding 3.5m or length exceeding 27.00m, provided that the license does not provide for prescription that may have an impact on traffic flow on the route by imposing special maneuvers or limiting the speed of the abnormal load vehicle.

Except for cranes vehicles not exceeding a mass of 96t, or a width of 3.00m.

Exceptions

Driving bans mentioned in the foregoing paragraphs, as regards roads other than motorways, do not apply to agricultural vehicles.

Additional information

Movements of abnormal loads are prohibited when there is snow or ice on the road and in case of fog, snowfall or rain reducing visibility to less than 200m.

The user or driver of the abnormal load vehicle or, where applicable, the traffic coordinator, must inspect the selected route at least 5 calendar days before the planned abnormal load transport.
