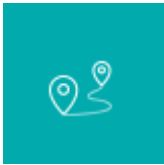

Exceptions

- a) vehicles engaged in combined transport operations, from the shipper to the nearest loading point or from the nearest unloading point to the consignee;
- b) vehicles used for essential seasonal agricultural transport;
- c) vehicles used in the construction, maintenance or repair of roads;
- d) vehicles transporting perishable goods, provided the goods take up more than half of the loading capacity of the vehicle;
- e) vehicles transporting livestock;
- f) vehicles transporting fuel for the continuous operation of service stations;
- g) vehicles used for the loading or unloading of aircraft, ships or trains up to a distance of 100km;
- h) vehicles carrying postal cargo;
- i) empty vehicles travelling in connection with any of the transport operations mentioned in the preceding points;
- j) vehicles needed in cases of natural disaster;
- k) vehicles belonging to the armed forces, police and fire brigade;
- l) vehicles carrying chemical substances susceptible to temperature change or crystallisation;
- m) vehicles used for driver training
