# Driving restrictions

Are there any driving restrictions on international HGV traffic at weekends or on public holidays?

**Yes**

The Directorate General of Traffic establishes special traffic regulation measures in most regions of Spain. The detailed measures are available in the document attached below.

In the Basque country and in Catalonia, local authorities are in charge of editing the rules. The rules for 2022 for Catalonia and for the Basque country are available below in the documents in attachment. The rules for 2023 will come in the upcoming months.

- This restriction shall not apply to vehicles which, due to their urgent use in fire prevention and extinguishing, environmental protection, maintenance of road conditions and the saving of human lives, must unavoidably circulate during the aforementioned restricted hours. To this end, at the time of starting the journey, the Traffic Management Centre of the affected area shall be informed of the complementary authorization number or, failing this, the vehicle registration number, as well as...



Vehicles with a gross vehicle weight exceeding 3,5t

### **In the event of adverse weather phenomena**

The circulation of certain types of vehicles may be restricted, without prejudice to the obligation for drivers of lorries with a gross vehicle weight exceeding 3,500 kilos, buses, articulated buses and vehicle combinations, to drive on the right-hand lane of the road, and not to overtake or pass in the event of snow, ice, low visibility due to fog or strong wind.

#### **Additional information**

In accordance with Article 5 of Royal Decree 97/2014, of 14 February, which regulates the transport of dangerous goods by road in Spanish territory, the routes to be used by vehicles for the transport of dangerous goods shall be:

- On journeys for distribution and delivery of dangerous goods to their final recipients or consumers: The most suitable route shall be used, both in terms of road safety and traffic flow, travelling the shortest possible distance along conventional roads to the point of delivery of the goods. It is essential to use the ring roads, bypasses or ring roads outside the towns, if any, and if there is more than one, they must use the one furthest outside the town, entering the town center only to carry out loading and unloading operations, and always using the access closest to the delivery point, except for justified reasons of force majeure.
- In other types of journeys: If the points of origin and destination of the journey are included within the RIMP -Red de Itinerarios para Mercancías Peligrosas- (Network of Routes for Dangerous Goods) listed in Annex IV of the resolution, the vehicles transporting them must obligatorily use them on their route. If one or both of these points are outside the RIMP, journeys must be made on those roads that allow access to the network by the nearest entrance or exit in the direction of travel, in order to ensure that the route on single carriageway roads is as short as possible.

Transit on roads other than those indicated here shall require that the itinerary does not pass through crossings or that it does so on those of lesser danger, in accordance with the intensity, classification and distribution of traffic, the size of the urban nucleus, the urban configuration, and the layout and regulation of the roads, and the layout and regulation of the same-, and in addition, prior notification at least twenty-four hours in advance to the Traffic Management Centre of the affected area, who, in coordination with the Sector of the Traffic Grouping of the Guardia Civil, will confirm whether the use of the new route is appropriate.

Likewise, it will be allowed to leave the RIMP by the nearest exit, in those journeys whose destination or origin is the usual residence of the driver; to carry out daily or weekly breaks; to carry out repair operations, vehicle maintenance or to access the base of the transport company, provided that, in any case, the safety and security conditions established in the ADR are met.

The provisions of the above paragraphs shall not apply when the carriage of this class of goods is carried out in accordance with any of the exemptions included in the ADR due to the load, quantity or type of carriage.

**Additional information**

Vehicles transporting dangerous goods over long distances shall be required to use the long-distance transport of dangerous goods shall use the Dangerous Goods Route Network (RIMP), as set out in Annex V of this Resolution. If the points of origin and/or destination of the movement are outside the RIMP, the RIMP must be the nearest entrance or exit in the direction of travel, in order to make the shortest possible journey outside the RIMP. It shall also be permitted to leave the RIMP for journeys where the destination or origin is the driver's usual residence; for daily or weekly rest periods; to carry out vehicle repair or maintenance operations; or for access to the base of the transport undertaking, provided that the parking conditions complied with ADR conditions.

In addition to the summer restrictions 2022 planned in the Basque country, special restrictions are added for trucks over 7500 kg.

Cross-border transport going in France, is restricted from 22:00 on 5 June until 22:00 on 6 June, for the following sections:

- AP-8 towards France from kp 104 (Erletxes)
- A-15 towards Donostia – San Sebastián
- N-121A towards Irún
- N-1 towards France from pk 406 (Etzegárate)
- A-1 towards France from the border with Burgos to pk 352 (Vitoria-Gasteiz)
- AP-1 towards Eibar from Pk 102.7 (Etxabarri Toll)
- GI-20 towards France
- GI-11 direction Donostia – San Sebastián
- GI 636 towards France

Additionally, from 4 June to 4 September, the following special traffic restrictions will apply:

On Saturdays, Sundays and holidays, from 11:00 to 14:00:

- A-8 towards Cantabria from kp 119.5
- A-1 direction Madrid from pk 352 (Vitoria-Gasteiz)

On Sundays and holidays, from 16:00 to 21:00:

- A-8 towards Irún from the border with Cantabria to pk 119.5
- A-1 towards France from the border with Burgos to pk 352 (Vitoria-Gasteiz)
